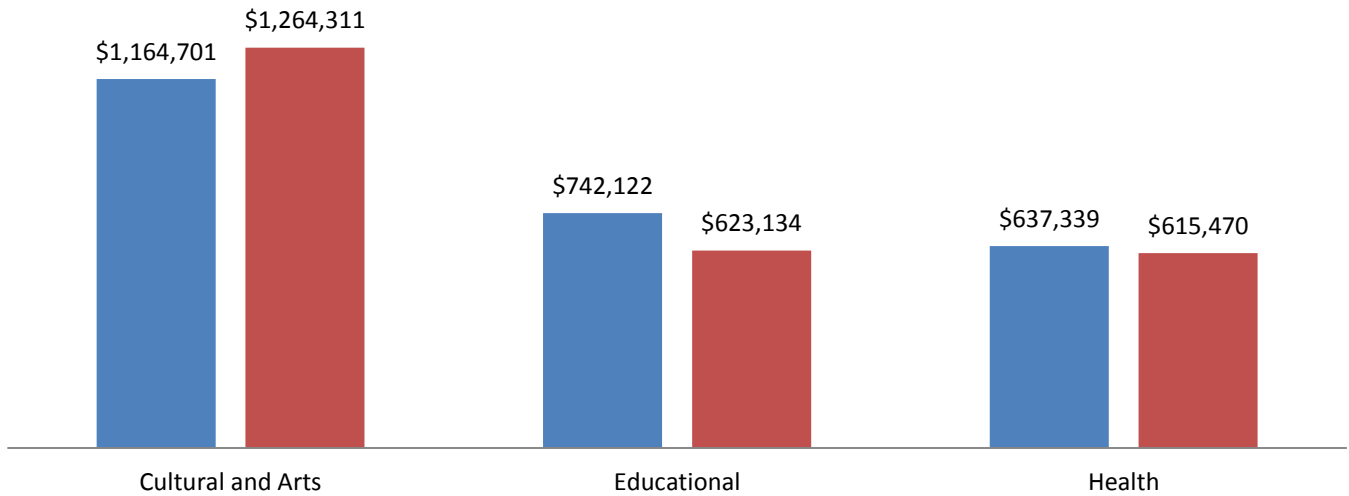

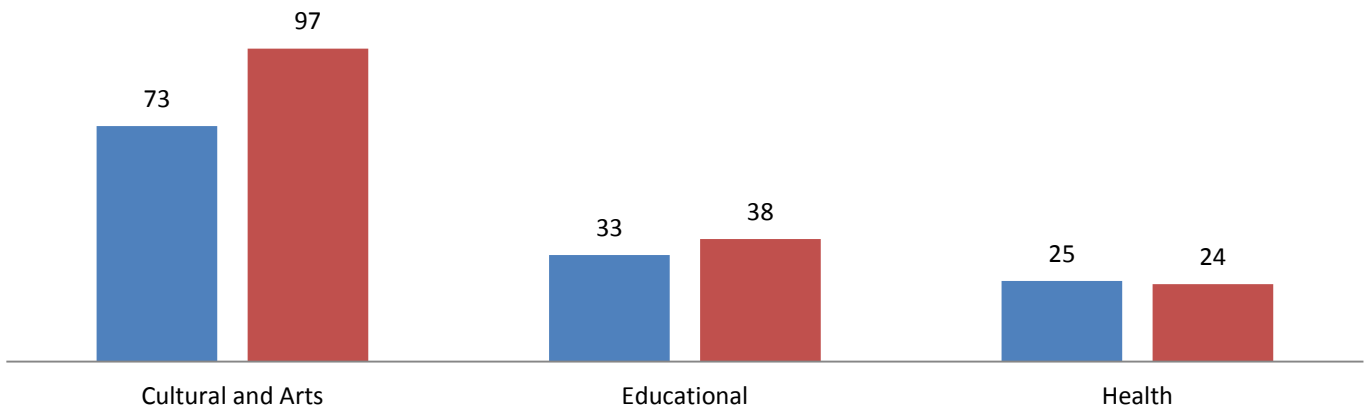
Dollars Awarded by Giving Category

Number of Grants by Giving Category

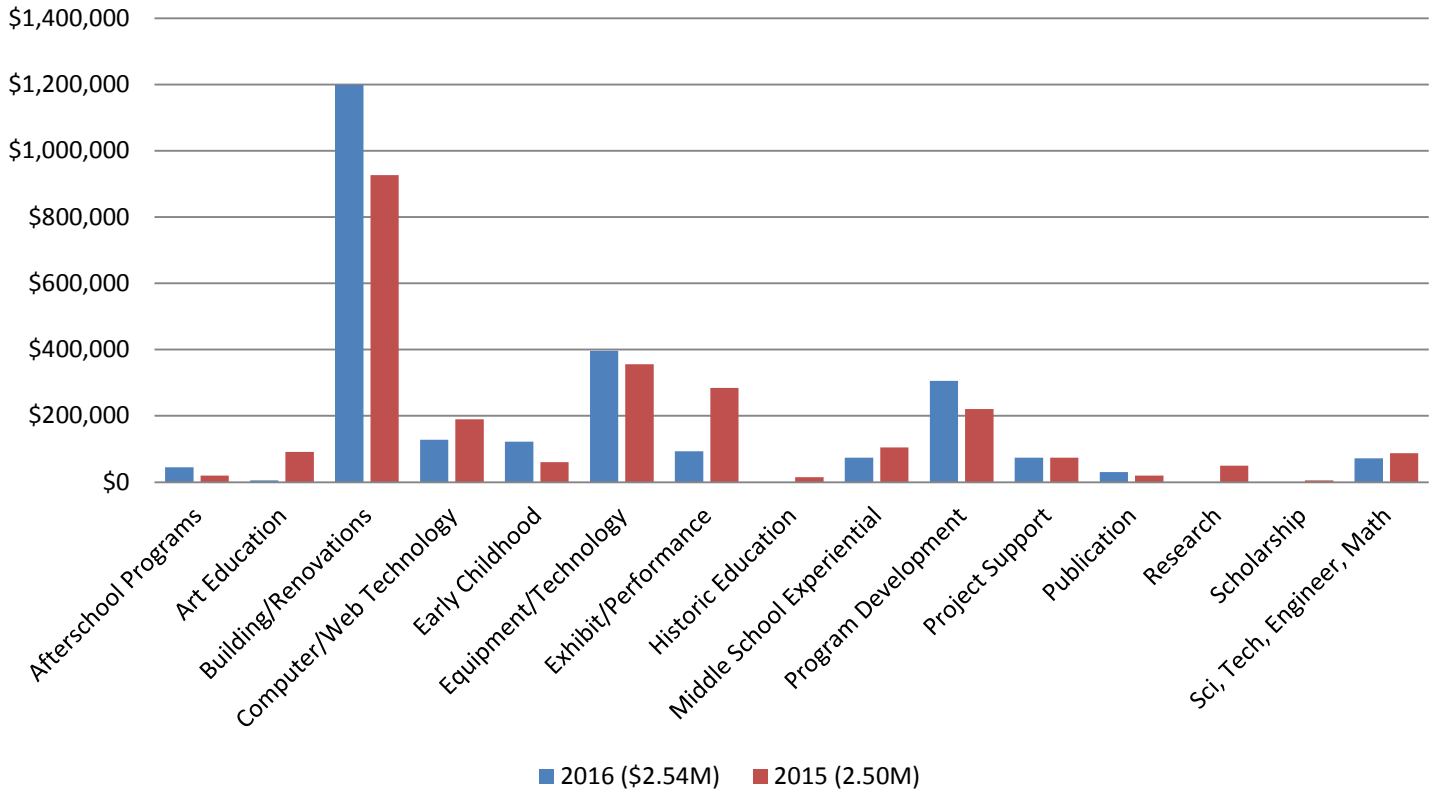

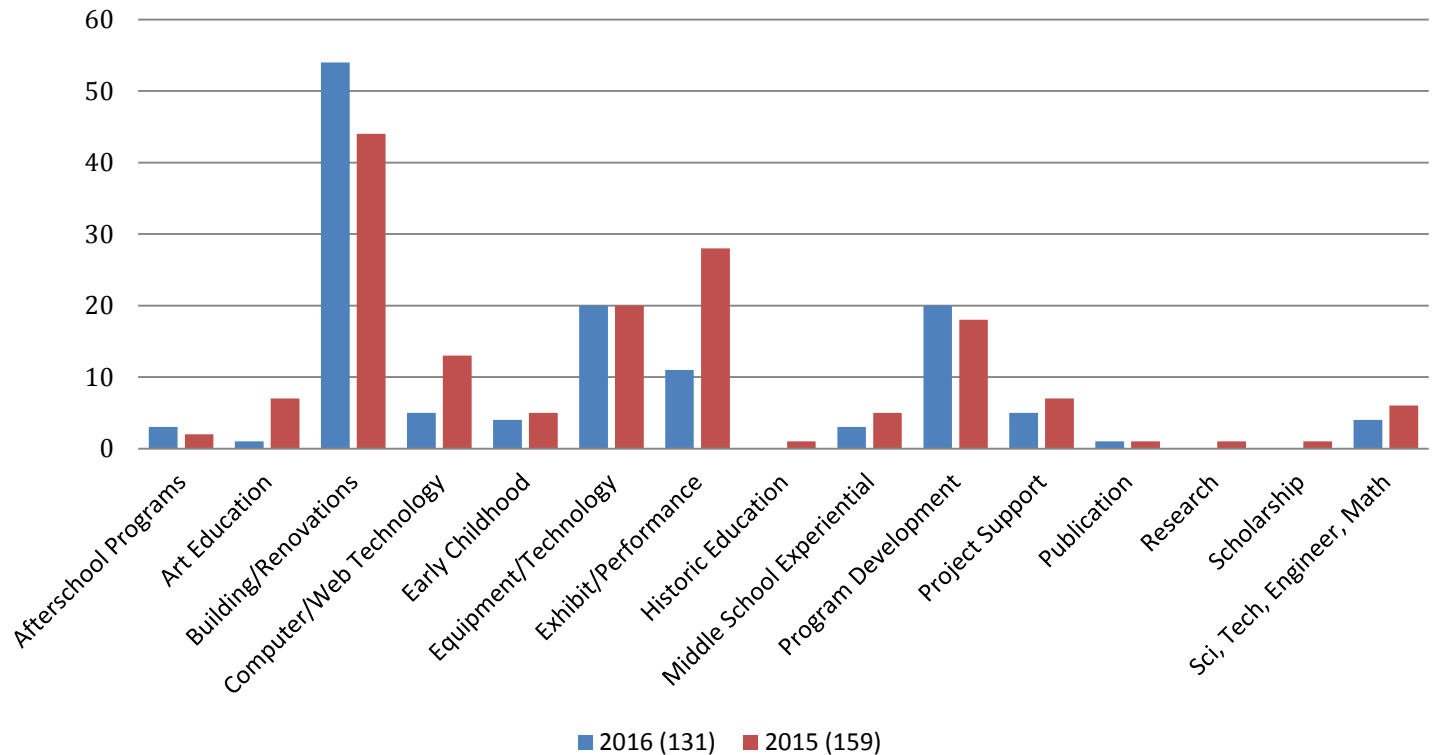
CULTURAL AND ARTS: Grants made to cultural and arts organizations represent 46% of the total giving and include three subcategories: Historical, Arts/Other and Library.

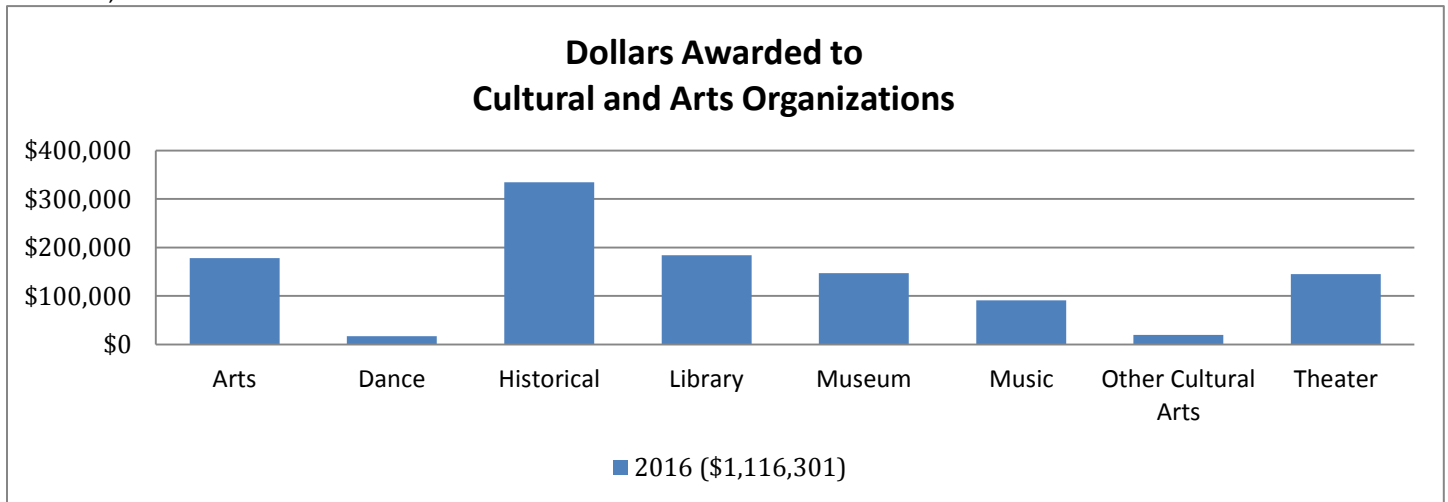
Dollars Awarded by Support Type



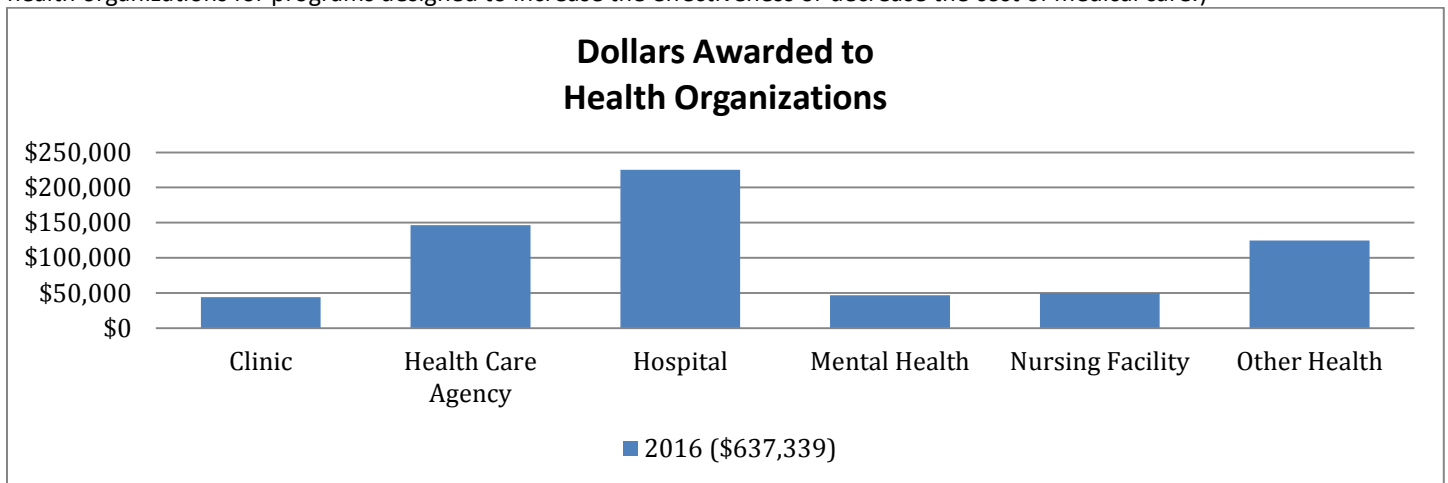
Number of Grants by Support Type



Cultural and Arts Organizations: Organizations whose *customary and primary activity* is to promote music, theater, drama, history, literature, the arts or other similar cultural activities.



Medical Organizations: Hospitals, clinics, and medical research organizations. (Trustees will consider requests from other *similar* health organizations for programs designed to increase the effectiveness or decrease the cost of medical care.)



Educational Organizations: Colleges, universities, and other educational institutions. (Grants are not made to public elementary and secondary schools, nor to schools that receive financial support from a church or other religious organization. Trustees will consider requests from other *educational organizations* whose purpose is to promote systemic change in education or provide innovative programs whose objectives are to improve education.)
